ON THE GEOLOGICAL INTERPRETATION OF SOME RECENT GEODETIC INVESTIGATIONS (BEING A SECOND APPENDIX TO THE MEMOIR ON THE STRUCTURE OF THE HIMA-LAYAS AND OF THE GANGETIC PLAIN AS ELUCIDATED BY GEODETIC OBSERVATIONS IN INDIA). BY B.D. OLDHAM, F.R.S.

CINCE the appearing the Memoir on the Structure of the Himalawas and of the Cangetic Plain, as elucidated by Geodetic Observations India India in the Support of the Mountains of Central Asia, other contributions to our knowledge of the subject have been published, of which three appear to require special consideration. Two of these have been and by the Survey of India, and contain the results of a large amount of computation, having important hearings on the problem of the origin of the Himalayas and, incidentally, on the wider one of the origin of mountains in general.3 The third is an important study of the question of compensation and isostas by Prof. A. Alessic, which contains also the results of the observations of gravity and detection of the plumb line, made in the course of the Filippi expedition to Central Asia.4

Had Col: Cowie's chricism been no more than its title indicates no useful purpose would be served by a newly controversial rejoinder, but, in addition, it contains some important results of computation. The criticisms and mumerous and detailed, in some cases they deal with mere slips of the pen or printer, in others they point out real mistakes, and in others again it is Col. Cowie who is in error. So far as they refer to matters of detail, I do not propose to deal with
